replaced by Msgr. George Halpin as Superintendent.

1962 - Rev. John P. Smyth arrives at Maryville on July 7th - his first assignment as a priest. Maryville's population is, once again, shrinking.

1969 - The last graduating class from Maryville's high school. All Maryville children now attended public schools in the district.

1970 - Rev. John Smyth is named Superintendent by Cardinal Cody.

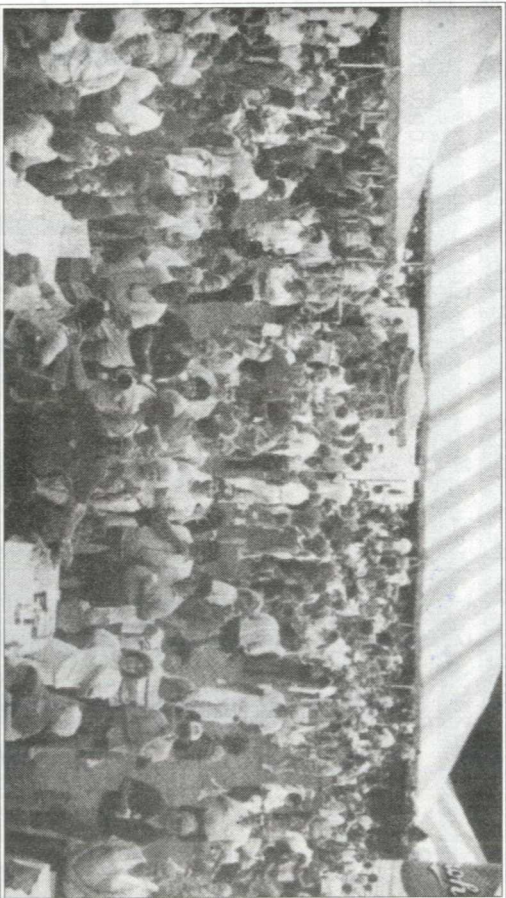

1971 - First Chuckwagon fundraiser is held. It grew into what was thought to be the largest, single day fundraiser in Illinois, eventually raising over \$2 million annually.

1972 - The first of two residential cottages are built at Maryville. Expansion of programs goes well beyond the Des Plaines campus.
